AN NACQJ JUDGE/CANDIDATE:

When judging or otherwise associated with a show, prioritizes the considerations of NACQJ and/or the host show ahead of their own business or personal concerns.

Is aware of their role as a leader in the community, exerting a positive influence while acting with diplomacy in the judging room and beyond.

Models professional and respectful behavior to maintain the integrity of NACQJ and their personal reputation.

Continually seeks more knowledge of the art and craft of quiltmaking.

Embraces new techniques, methods, and styles of quiltmaking.

Is mindful of the importance of positivity in comments, actions, and communications.

Renders a fair, objective, and equitable evaluation of each item in competition.

Sets aside personal preferences when rendering decisions.

Strives to instill confidence and pride in any exhibitor's achievements.

Encourages exhibitors to elevate their design and technical skills.

Is prepared to explain any remark for the benefit of the exhibitor.

Welcomes general questions about quilt judging.

Promotes and continues the tradition of support and sharing that has been a part of quiltmaking.
